1. Dr. Radovan Karadzic hereby provides notice to the Trial Chamber and Prosecution that he may seek to re-open his case to offer an additional exhibit into evidence.

2. On 1 October 2013, a large number of previously classified documents were released to the public by the United States Government through the William Jefferson Clinton library. After reviewing those documents, Dr. Karadzic requested from the United States Government some further documents that were referenced in the newly-released ones. Among the documents requested was:

Copy of the cable from Brigadier Jones referred to in the memorandum of the deputies committee meeting of 22 February 1993 on p. 2 in which it was attached and allegedly reported that the Muslims were responsible for all UNPROFOR casualties.

3. This document was finally provided to Dr. Karadzic, in redacted form, on 22 July 2014 pursuant to Rule 70.

4. Upon receipt of the document, Dr. Karadzic recognized that it had evidentiary value to his case and requested on that same day that the United States Government agree that it can be used as a public exhibit in his case. Under the current Rule 70 conditions, the document cannot be disclosed to anyone other than Dr. Karadzic and his Legal Advisor Peter Robinson.


5. On 23 July 2014, the United States Government advised that it was considering Dr. Karadzic's request.

6. Should the United States allow the use of the document, it is Dr. Karadzic's intention to file a motion to re-open his case and to seek admission of the document, or, if necessary, admission of testimony to authenticate the document.

7. Dr. Karadzic is notifying the Trial Chamber of this situation at the earliest time so that it is informed of these developments.
