I, **THEODOR MERON**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Request for Appointment of Special Chamber”, filed by Radovan Karadžić (“Karadžić”) on 27 September 2013 (“Request”);

NOTING that Karadžić requests that I appoint a special chamber to “consider whether to appoint an *amicus curiae* prosecutor to investigate possible contempt of the Tribunal by former Prosecutor Carla Del Ponte” in the case of *Prosecutor v. Slobodan Milošević*, Case No. IT-02-54-T;¹

NOTING Rule 19(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, which authorizes the President to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

CONSIDERING the trial management and case distribution needs of the Tribunal;
