
1. On 20 June 2013, the Trial Chamber issued an invitation to the government of France requesting that it cooperate with the defence by obtaining answers to questions from one of its former officers, and authorizing that officer to testify as a defence witness.¹

2. The government of France was given three weeks to respond to the invitation. More than four weeks have passed and France has not responded.

3. The Trial Chamber is respectfully requested to issue a second invitation to France requesting it to respond to the request within five days. If no timely response to this second invitation is received, Dr. Karadzic will move for a binding order pursuant to Rule 54 *bis* compelling the government of France to cooperate with his defence team by obtaining the required information or permitting his Legal Advisor Peter Robinson to interview the former officer.
